

**ANNUAL NOTICE OF PARENTAL RIGHTS IN PUBLIC EDUCATION**

53A-15-1501

Ignite Entrepreneurship Academy will ‘reasonably accommodate’ and make its best effort to enable a parent or guardian to exercise parental right while balancing:

- The educational needs of other students
- The academic and behavioral impact to the classroom
- The teacher’s workload
- The assurance of the safe and efficient operation of the school
- The impact to staff and resources (working conditions, safety and supervision and allocation of funds)

53A-15-1502 Annually notify of parental rights

53A-15-1503

Ignite Entrepreneurship Academy acknowledges the guardian as the primary person responsible for the education of the student, and will reasonably academically accommodate on an individual basis:

- Written requests for retention on grade level based on academic ability, social, emotional or physical maturity
- Parent’s initial selection of a teacher or teacher change
- Request of a parent to visit and observe any class the student attends
- Excuse the student from attendance for a family event or health care provider without obtaining a note from the provider
- Excuse absences (with no diminished expectations for academic performance)
- Written request for specialized/advanced class
- Requests to meet with a teacher at a mutually agreeable time if unable to attend a regularly scheduled parent-teacher conference
- Written request to opt out of statewide NAEP tests with no negative impact to grade
- Provide/distribute a copy of school’s discipline and conduct policy to each student (signature of parent acknowledging receipt)
- Notify parent of violation of discipline or conduct policy and allow the parent to respond
