# Ignite Entrepreneurship Academy Student Fee Schedule Elementary School Students

General Information:

1. All fees listed are the maximum amount charged per student for each class or school-sponsored activity. Actual amount charged may be less.
2. The amount specified for travel, accommodations, and clinics in elementary school is the total which may be spent per student whether from student contributions, fund-raising activities, or donations.
3. Any payment for student participation in a required class, program, or activity is a fee and is subject to the fee waiver requirement.
4. Any payment required for participation in an after-school extra-curricular program is optional and not subject to the fee waiver requirement.
5. For information on fee waivers and other details, contact your school administrator.
6. All students are responsible to pay for any loss, breakage, or damage they cause to school property. Loss breakage, or damage is not subject to the waiver requirement.
7. School supplies must be provided for elementary students. An elementary school or teacher may compile and provide to a student's parent a suggested list of supplies for use during the regular school day so that a parent may furnish, on a voluntary basis, those supplies for student use. Otherwise, they will be furnished by the school.
8. Donations are permissible in both elementary and secondary schools, but all such requests are voluntary. A student may not be excluded from an activity or program because they did not donate. For additional information see IEA Policy-School Fees and Fee Waiver Policy.

All requests for overnight travel must be approved and comply with IEA's Overnight Field Trip Policy.
Other	\$7.00	Required	Field Trip Apparel Fee (student will be provided with required field trip t-shirt to promote student safety and quick identification within a group.)
Extra-curricular Activities "Extracurricular" means an activity, course, or program, outside of school hours, that is sponsored, recognized, or sanctioned by the District.	\$25.00-\$200.00	Optional	On-campus after-school programs; Program session dates and offerings to be released in Ignite After-School Program Guide.
