



Annual Acceptance of Policies

1. I have read Ignite Entrepreneurship Academy's school mission, belief statements, purpose and goals. I agree to support IEA as it pursues fulfillment of its mission.
2. As a charter school, IEA strives to offer students the opportunity to excel academically, and as such, we depend upon volunteerism to provide some services and supplies for which regular public schools receive more state funding than charter schools. In addition, by offering the opportunity for volunteer service, IEA builds a sense of community and investment in our programs. I understand and agree that our family is expected to provide at least 1 hour per week or 40 hours of volunteer service each year we have children enrolled at Ignite. Volunteerism can occur in a number of ways and details regarding this will be provided at the onset of each school year.
3. I assure that my child is only enrolled at IEA, as dual enrollment in more than one public school is not permissible. I also understand that enrollment at IEA is voluntary, and that if I do not agree with the educational philosophy of IEA, I am free to place my children in regular public schools, or in another charter school with a philosophy more to my liking. Therefore, I will promote the vision of IEA by using positive communication, courtesy and respect when interacting with staff, students, parents and anyone else in the school community. I will follow IEA's communication model, specifically, I will take any concerns I have directly to the person most able to successfully address those concerns, and not to others who cannot address the concern. I will work in a cooperative manner to promote the school mission.
4. I understand that my child will be required to follow the school dress code and student conduct policy, as specified in the IEA Family Handbook.
5. I understand that it is my responsibility to provide transportation for my child(ren) to and from school and I agree to do this in accordance with the Arrival and Pick-up Procedures outlined in the Parent/Student Handbook.
6. I understand the IEA has a goal of 95% attendance for students. I will work to schedule appointments and lessons outside of school hours. I will bring my student to school on time. I understand that if my child is absent 10 consecutive school days he/she may be unenrolled from IEA, according to school district guidelines.
7. I understand that I **must** complete all required registration documents and provide copies of my child's birth certificate and immunization records to the school registrar in order for my child's enrollment at IEA to be complete. A lack of compliance with this requirement in a timely manner and by the date specified in my approval letter may result in my child losing their eligibility to attend IEA.
